

To Save a Profile in OnAir with the current Showlog Page and Library View

Pre-Requisite: 5.2.0.315 or higher of OnAir

To setup this feature:

Click on the 'Gear' at the top right corner of the main OnAir screen.



You should now see the OnAir workstation page

Click 'Update' the 'Save' when complete. You should now see 'Yes' under the showlog and/or library column in the Profile page display.

Return to your main OnAir screen once you have setup all desired Profiles with the respective showlog and/or library save settings.

Example:

I have created a 'Rick' and 'Morning Profile and saved separate library and showlog pages to each profile's 'Default' layout. When I select the 'Rick' profile, I see the following layout.

When I select the 'Morning' layout, I see the following screen.

As you can see from the above two screen shots I have completely different library view settings and showlog pages between the two Profiles. Enable the 'Save Settings' feature for any and all Profiles that you wish to have unique showlog and/or library view settings saved.

Release notes for 5.2.0.315

Changes,

- Profile / Layout can now save currently loaded showlog name and library settings (search visible, category bar visible and field display).

- > On the workstation profile display the user can select to save these (or not) with the layouts.
 - > When selected to save the user must "Save a layout" from the Bridge to capture the showlog and/or library settings they want to be reloaded.
